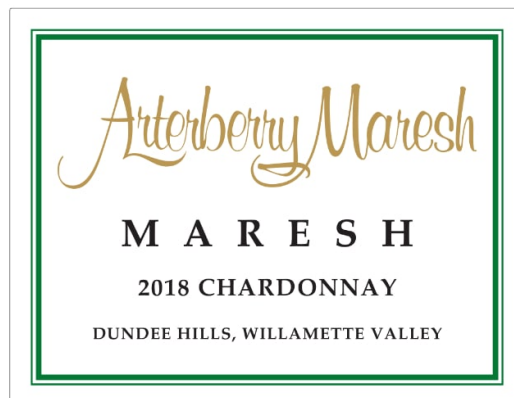

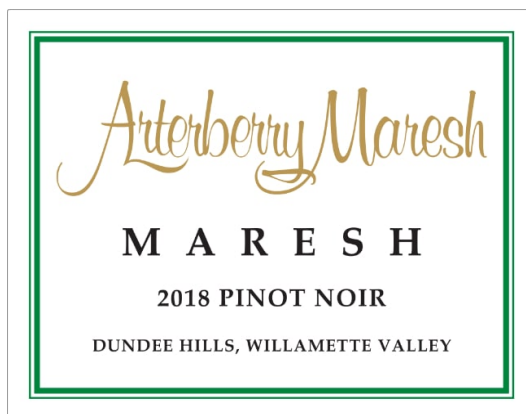

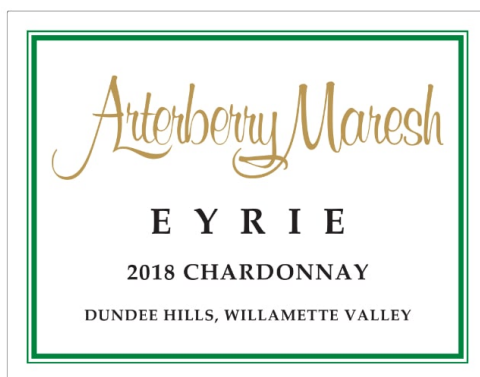

#### **2018 Arterberry Maresh • Chardonnay Maresh Vineyard**

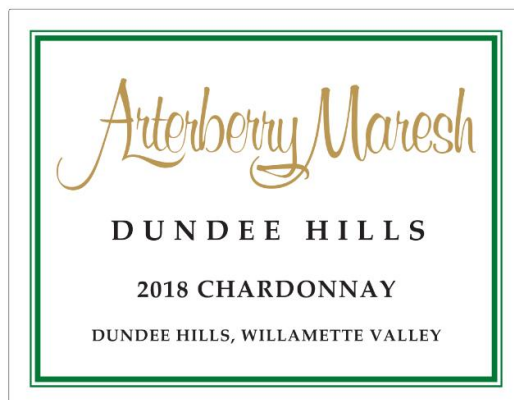
The 2018 Chardonnay Maresh Vineyard manages power and elegance, with gunflint notes that flush out to pure roasted almonds, saline, white flowers and apple fruit on the nose. The palate offers intense, savory flavor layers in an elegant, satin-like frame, with dynamic acidity and a long, ethereal finish. This has the flesh and structure to age very well in bottle.

**95+ points****2018 Arterberry Maresh • Pinot Noir Maresh Vineyard**

The 2018 Pinot Noir Maresh Vineyard is an incredible wine. It opens slowly to an arresting perfume of dusty earth, dried rose petals, tea leaves, licorice and amaro with a wealth of bright red berry fruit at the core. The palate is elegant, supple and juicy, with an expansive fan of layered, spicy flavors and a very long finish. It's hard to resist now, but it will have more to offer with time in bottle.

**94+ points****2018 Arterberry Maresh • Chardonnay Eyrrie Vineyard**

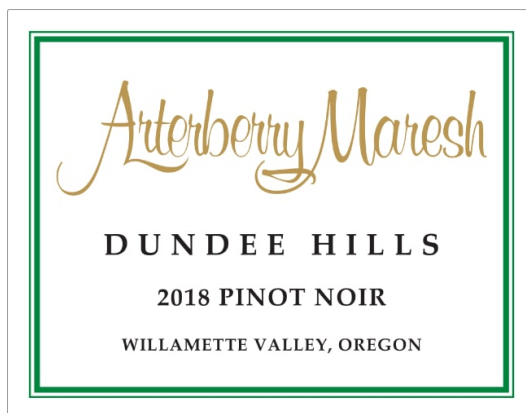
The 2018 Chardonnay Eyrrie Vineyard comes from the old vines planted in 1968 to Draper selection. Jim Maresh has crafted a stunning wine with the fruit from Jason Lett's property, a layered, complex wine full of personality. It has inviting aromas of spring honey, crushed almonds, quince, spice and mineral tones. The medium-bodied palate is satiny, savory and intense, maintaining an energetic sense of tanginess and minerality, particularly on the ethereal finish. If you can get your hands on some, stash it away for another 2-3 years.

**2018 Arterberry Maresh • Dundee Hills Chardonnay**

The 2018 Dundee Hills Chardonnay is wonderfully inviting and hedonistic! It has a perfume of spiced apples and quince, hazelnuts and beeswax, with wafts of floral perfume. The palate is broad, creamy and loaded with honeyed fruits, with juicy freshness to help carry the long, powerfully fruited finish.

**2018 Arterberry Maresh • Pinot Noir Dundee Hills**

Pale ruby-purple, the 2018 Pinot Noir Dundee Hills takes its time to open, unfolding slowly to cherries, boysenberries, floral perfume and earthy nuances. The palate is elegant with pure fruit character framed by dusty tannins and rounded acidity, finishing long and nuanced. How pretty!
