## **Dundee Hills Pinot Noir \$39**

#### Wine Advocate 96 points

The 2019 Dundee Hills Chardonnay was matured for 12 months in barrel and six months in stainless steel. It has a pure perfume of white orchard fruits laced with beeswax, almonds and flint. The palate is satiny and energetic from its linear acidity and expansive, gently honeyed layers, and it finishes long and youthfully shimmery. This is an excellent candidate for some extended time in the cellar. - Erin Brooks, Wine Advocate

## Old Vines Pinot Noir \$59

## **VINOUS 96 points**

Glistening scarlet. A highly complex bouquet evokes red berry and cherry preserves, along with building Asian spice, rose oil and smoky mineral flourishes. Shows fine delineation and seamless texture, offering concentrated, spice-tinged Chambord, cherry, cola and spice cake flavors that pick up a strong rose pastille nuance with air. Finishes extremely long and pure, with fine-grained tannins providing framework and gentle grip to lingering red fruit, five-spice powder and savory herb notes. 70% of this fruit comes from the estate Maresh vineyard and the other 30% is from the neighboring Weber vineyard; the vast majority of the vines were planted in the late 1970s. - Josh Raynolds, Vinous Media.

#### **VINOUS 95 points**

Full, bright-rimmed red. Potent, mineral-accented cherry and red berry aromas are complemented by suggestions of five-spice powder, cola and candied flowers. Silky, energetic and alluringly sweet, offering vibrant raspberry, cherry pie and rose pastille flavors that show superb detail and spicy back-end lift. Deftly balanced and focused on the incisive finish, which is framed by discreet, polished tannins. - Josh Raynolds, Vinous Media

The 2018 Pinot Noir Maresh Vineyard is an incredible wine. It opens slowly to an arresting perfume of dusty earth, dried rose petals, tea leaves, licorice and amaro with a wealth of bright red berry fruit at the core. The palate is elegant, supple and juicy, with an expansive fan of layered, spicy flavors and a very long finish. It's hard to resist now, but it will have more to offer with time in bottle.

The 2018 Pinot Noir Weber Vineyard comes from Pommard clone vines planted in 1983. It features pure aromas of cranberry and black raspberry with botanical and floral layers. The palate is seamless and complex, with powerful flavors, a silty texture and bright acidity, finishing with layer after layer of sweet berry fruit. - Erin Brooks, Wine Advocate
